

The average growth rate of 0.54% experienced in the previous decades is projected to continue through 2045, at an average rate of 0.53%.



Community Profile- Race & Ethnicity

Results of the 2020 U.S. Census indicate that people from White alone (not Hispanic or Latino) and Black alone (not Hispanic or Latino) race comprise the majority of Somerset County's population, at 52.3% and 38.4% respectively.

In 2011, the average wage per job for Somerset County was \$39,652 (in current dollars). The average wage increased to \$54,689 in 2021, which translates to a 37.9% change.



Community Profile- Housing


The median residential sale price in Somerset County increased from \$147,500 to \$185,000. Values for the years 2019, 2020, and 2021 indicate an emerging upward trend.


The total number of individual farms in Somerset County decreased from 301 in 2002 to 255 in 2017.
